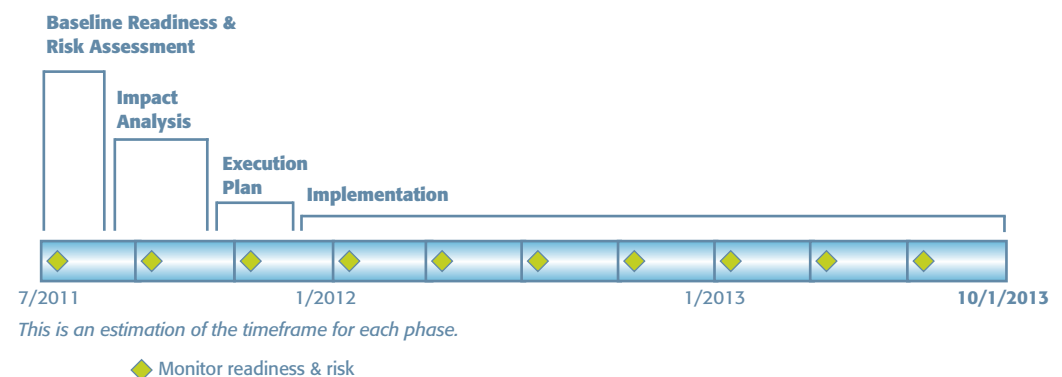

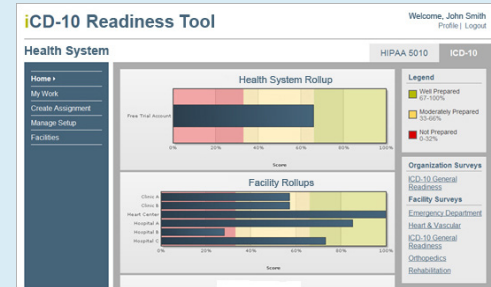
Technical specifications

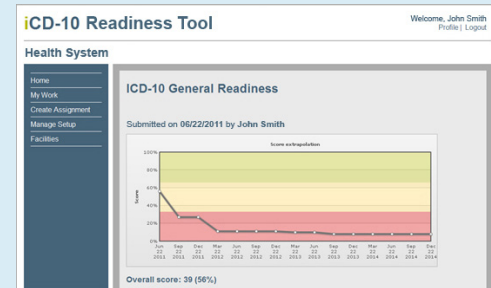
Orientation and support
