Noblis Achieves Climate Registered Status by Verifying its Carbon Footprint

The Climate Registry Recognizes Noblis as a Leader in Carbon Management

Climate Registered status is awarded to members of The Climate Registry who measure, publicly report, and have their greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory (or carbon footprint) verified by a third-party auditor.

“When it comes to environmental programs, Climate Registered leads the pack because it requires corporations to measure their entire North American carbon footprint, verify the findings with an independent third party, and publicly report the results,” said Doug Scott, Chairman of The Climate Registry and Commissioner of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. “It is comprehensive and transparent and there is no other program out there as rigorous as the Climate Registered program.”

Noblis was recognized for its status as Climate Registered at the annual North American Climate Policy Forum on 23 June in Chicago. “As a founding reporter, Noblis is delighted to be recognized for its status as Climate Registered, because it shows that we are leaders in carbon management and it demonstrates that we practice what we preach,” said Noblis Senior Manager Robert Wassmann. “Noblis has developed comprehensive GHG emissions assessment and strategic planning tools and services, for both the government and private sector.
